RESIDENT RESEARCH TRAVEL AWARD

155th ANNUAL SPRING MEETING April 29 - May 1, 2022 Dallas, TX

Deadline for submission – October 15, 2021

THE AWARD

The American Otological Society has established two resident research travel awards in the amount of \$2,000 for the best clinical and basic science paper in Otology submitted by a Resident/Fellow in training in the field of Otology. Residents from any approved residency program in Otology in the United States or Canada are eligible to compete. The author will be expected to attend the Annual AOS Spring Meeting and present the paper as an oral presentation.

AUTHORSHIP

The Resident must be the primary author and provide the main inspiration for the paper, do the literature search, data collection, original and final drafts of the article, the discussion, and the conclusions. A staff sponsor may be listed as co-author or second author. The sponsor or staff consultant may only provide editorial help, cases for study, and/or a research laboratory setting for carrying out bench research.

THE PAPER

The paper is to be an original contribution, not previously published. A clinical study or basic research study is acceptable. Single-case reports or literature reviews are not acceptable. The paper is to be submitted in the publication format recommended by *Otology & Neurotology*, the official journal of the American Otological Society. An electronic submission of the manuscript, including illustrations will be required. The name of the author and any other identifying information should appear on the cover sheet only.

DEADLINE

An abstract must be submitted through the AOS website <u>www.americanotologicalsociety.org</u> on or before October 15th with the full manuscript (rough draft ok) submitted to the AOS office by December 6th (The abstract must be selected as an Oral presentation to be considered).
